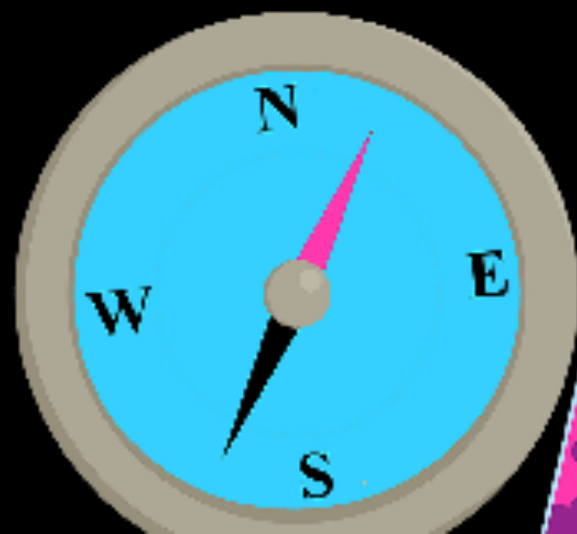

Arrival and Dismissal

Students must be in their classroom and ready to work by 7:45 each day to avoid an unexcused tardy. School is dismissed at 3:30 each day.

Student Laptops

- Student Laptops will be assigned to students
- ALL forms must be signed prior to students using laptops
- Students are to be responsible for their laptop during the day

COPPA

- ◆ Children's Online Privacy and Protection Act
- ◆ FCC put this law in place to protect minors from online dangers.
- ◆ Teachers will guide internet use of students.
- ◆ No student 13 and under will be able to access the internet in any way without a signed COPPA form.
- ◆ Please sign a COPPA form tonight and turn it in so your child will be ready to go at the beginning of the year.

Why Laptops?

- ◆ **Federal, State, and County curricula require that students become proficient in the use of technology.**
- ◆ **The US Department of Education states in the Partnership for 21st Century Skills that student proficiency means using the appropriate technology tools and applying them to various tasks within the classroom.**
- ◆ **Help students become life long learners.**
- ◆ **Help teachers accommodate individual student needs.**
- ◆ **Prepare students for an unimaginable job market.**

- ◆ **One laptop**
- ◆ **Power cord/charger**
- ◆ **Battery**
- ◆ **Laptop case**
- ◆ **Appropriate software**

Laptop Distribution

- ◆ **Students registered for 6th grade will be issued a laptop after a parent meeting is conducted and proper parent and student signatures are provided.**
- ◆ **The laptop will be assigned in the same manner as a textbook.**
- ◆ **The serial number of the laptop will be recorded. It will also be assigned a barcode and checked out through the media center.**
- ◆ **Once the laptop is issued to a student, it will stay with the student for the remainder of the school year or until the student withdraws from school. Students who transfer within the county will be assigned a laptop at their new location.**
- ◆ **Students will be reassigned their original laptop each year while enrolled at CWMS.**

Laptop Distribution

- ◆ Wilkes County Schools will loan a laptop to students upon compliance with the following:
 - ◆ 6th grade parent orientation
 - ◆ A signed Acceptable Use Policy
 - ◆ An agreement signed by the student and parent

Responsibility

- ◆ **It is the responsibility of the students to care for the laptop and all other equipment in the manner outlined in the Middle School Laptop Handbook.**
- ◆ **Misuse or abuse of the laptop and other equipment will result in loss of use and/or financial restitution. Accidental damage or neglect will result in a \$50.00 insurance deductible.**

All Student laptops will stay on campus, they are not allowed to go home.
